IIDC supports the work of development partners and strengthens civil society through capacity development support and offering technical advice on selected but diverse development issues. IIDC is seeking highly motivated and organized persons to fill the following positions.

1. LEARNING, ADAPTATION AND SCALE UP TECHNICAL ADVISOR

This is a senior position at IIDC whose purpose is to support IIDC implementing partners to innovate, adapt and scale up evidence based and impact oriented programmes and approaches to addressing social development problems.

The broad job tasks and responsibilities include

1. Spearheading IIDC's technical support to partners in the development and implementation of adaptation and scale up strategies and programmes.
2. Instituting, coordinating and maintaining collaborative/joint learning initiatives and programmes among partners.
3. Strengthening the learning and impact orientation of IIDC and partners

Required Qualifications and Experience:

- a) At least an advanced degree in either Development Management, Monitoring and Evaluation, Programme design and Management or a related field.
 - b) Strong grounding in social research methodologies and methods is a must.
 - c) Specialized training in adult learning approaches and methods is a highly added advantage.
- At least 10 years' work experience and practical expertise in the following:
- Capacity development and technical assistance programming and delivery
 - Designing and implementing programme adaptation and scale up initiatives
 - Working with and supporting government departments and agencies
 - Organizing and executing learning events and processes including communities of practice
 - Experience in child rights related programming is a highly added advantage.

2. IT TECHNICAL SUPPORT OFFICER

The IT Technical Support Officer will be responsible for the smooth running of computer systems and ensuring that users get maximum benefits from them; monitor and maintain the computer systems and networks of the organization, installing and configuring computer systems, website management, diagnosing hardware and software faults and solving technical and applications challenges.

Required Qualifications and Experience

- Bachelors in Information Technology, Computer Science or a related field;
- At least 3 years of experience providing Information Communications Technology (ICT) and administrative support in a development context;
- Experience working with backend administration of websites is a MUST.
