Jhpiego is an international, non-profit health organization affiliated with The Johns Hopkins University. For almost 40 years and in over 150 countries, Jhpiego has worked to prevent the needless deaths of women and their families. Jhpiego works with health experts, governments and community leaders to develop strategies that help countries care for themselves by training health care workers, strengthening health systems and improving delivery of care.

Through funding from the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), Jhpiego is implementing the Health Workforce for the 21 Century (HW21) project in Uganda. This five-year funded initiative supports high HIV burden countries in achieving the UNAID's 95-95-95 goals by 2030 through the implementation of programs that focus on training competent and confident health care workers and effectively supporting governments to employ, deploy, and retain these workers. HW21 is contributing to ensuring Sustainable HIV Epidemic Control through Improved health care workers' HIV service delivery capacity through Continuous Professional Development (CPD) by building tele-education/tele-mentoring technology platforms. This above-site mechanism supports the MoH and USG regional Implementing Partners (IPs) to roll out and implement a Hub and Spoke model for virtual learning, mentorship and supervision. HW21 is helping to bridge health workforce gaps by improving access to testing, care, treatment, and support for people living with HIV (PLHIV) and by ensuring sustained viral suppression.
